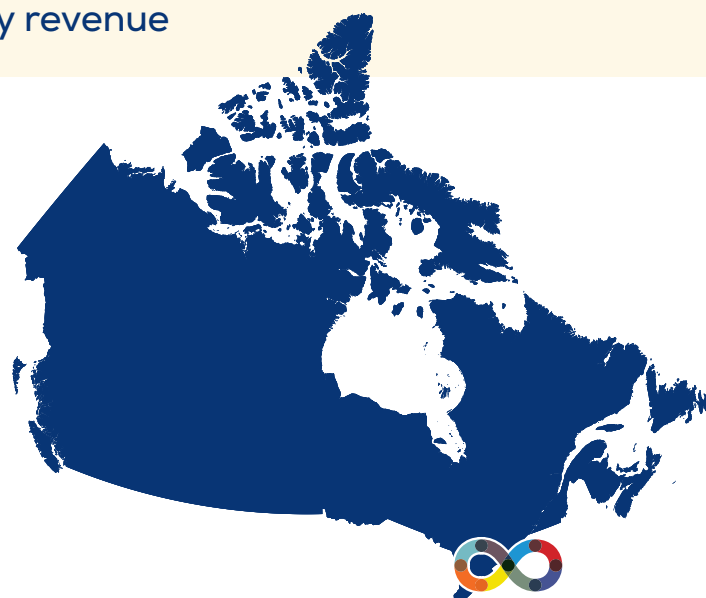

RSSOM - Tracks and Civil Joint Venture

NGE is a main partner in the RSSOM project (Ontario Line Rolling Stock, Systems, Operations and Maintenance) in Toronto, participating in the construction of track, systems and the Operations and Maintenance Site Facilities (OMSF), which support the long-term operation of the 15.6 km of fully automated line by delivering efficient, high-performance infrastructure for the metro system.

RSSOM - Overhead Catenary System

NGE is delivering the overhead catenary system for the RSSOM project on Toronto's Ontario Line, installing a 1.5 kV system across open sections, depots, and tunnels. This infrastructure ensures reliable power supply and supports the performance and sustainability of the fully automated metro network.



OnCorr - Overhead Catenary System

The OnCorr project covers engineering studies and construction of the overhead catenary system of Toronto's RER GO Expansion network, including electrification of over 100 km of rail corridor and a depot in an operational environment. It supports the modernization and capacity growth of the regional rail network.



REM - Trackwork maintenance

Within the context of the REM project in Montréal, NGE carries out heavy maintenance works for the tracks and turnouts of the line, applying its expertise and decades of experience in track maintenance to one of Canada's most emblematic transportation projects.
